ユニット ②	過去完了進行形	E.g., When we finally got there, Bill had been waiting for over an hour.
ユニット ③	間接話法	E.g., My daughter said that she wanted a dog, but I said she couldn't have one.
ユニット ④	Time: For, While, During	E.g., I lived there for three years. She worked at a restaurant while she was studying at college.
ユニット ⑤	順序を表す副詞	E.g., First, we went snorkeling. Then, we decided to take scuba diving lessons.
ユニット ⑥	Both, Neither, Either	E.g., Tokyo and Osaka were both very interesting. Neither of us enjoyed the food in Turkey.

ユニット ①	単純過去形と不規則変化動詞	E.g., I drank coffee. / I didn't drink tea. Did you drink cocoa? / What did you drink?
ユニット ②	付加疑問文	E.g., You're from the US, aren't you? / He can't sing very well, can he?
ユニット ③	受動態	E.g., The mail isn't delivered on Sundays. / When was this bridge built?
ユニット ④	-ing / -ed で終わる形容詞	E.g., It wasn't an interesting party. I was pretty bored.
ユニット ⑤	再帰代名詞	E.g., She introduced herself to my parents. I traveled around South America by myself.
ユニット ⑥	Both, Neither, Either	E.g., Both Papa Gino's and Mama Gina's has a table available, so we can go to either.
