過去完了進行形

間接話法

My daughter said that she wanted a dog, but I said she couldn't have one.

Time: For, While, During

I lived there for three years. She worked at a restaurant while she was studying at college.

順序を表す副詞

First, we went snorkeling. Then, we decided to take scuba diving lessons.

Both, Neither, Either

Tokyo and Osaka were both very interesting. Neither of us enjoyed the food in Turkey.

We'd been traveling for almost twelve hours by the time we finally arrived at the hotel.

単純過去形と 不規則変化動詞

I drank coffee. / I didn't drink tea. Did you drink cocoa? / What did you drink?

付加疑問文

You're from the US, aren't you? / He can't sing very well, can he?

受動態

The mail isn't delivered on Sundays. / When was this bridge built?

-ing /-ed で終わる

It wasn't an interesting party. I was pretty bored.

再帰代名詞

She introduced herself to my parents. I traveled around South America by myself.

Both, Neither, Either

Both Papa Gino's and Mama Gina's has a table available, so we can go to either.

例えば…

同じ単語でも、語尾が -ing か -ed かで大きく意味が変わります。

boring/bored の場合

全く楽しくないパーティーだった。私は退屈していた。 と表しているのはどっち???

It wasn't a very good party. I was really boring

It wasn't a very exciting party.
